# Stamps with a perfin

# **Purpose:**

The purpose of this exhibit is to show Greek stamps used by companies, societies and bank organizations which are perfined. Showed is the original stamp with perfin + description of the stamp and catalogue identification + a reduced scan from + 75% of the back to give a better view of the perfin.

This exhibit is built up on a chronological base, starting with the first known user and sorted by catalogue numbers. Some types of perfins are known as very rare. High quality of perfined stamps is very difficult, in the past were perfined stamps seen as damaged and mostly put away. Where possible is exposed a cover / postcard with perfined stamps.

#### Introduction:

#### **Definition**

The term perfin is an acronym derived from the words **PERF**orated **IN**itials. Perfins are a number of small punched holes in a distinct pattern, as perforated letters, numerals or symbols, applied to postage and revenue stamps, that originally were utilized by companies and organizations to restrict usage of their stamps to authorized individuals. In the early days of postage stamps it was possible to return mint postage stamps to the post office and exchange them for cash. Stealing of stamps by dishonest company employees was therefore a lucrative way to make extra money. Perforated stamps could not be returned to the post office.

Perfined stamps were used in Greece during the period  $\pm$  1901 till  $\pm$  1948.

During the first period, 1901 till 30 April 1930, no license was required, but from 30 April 1930 till + 1948 a Post Office license was required.

In the Greek Post decree – law 4581 - of 30 April 1930 article 15 - it states that perfins where allowed if a fee of 1000 drachmas has been paid. Some years later this fee was reduced to 500 drachmas.

A few companies and banks, all with a high postage stamp usage, applied for and got licenses from the Post Office to perforate their stamps.

# Methodology:

The collection has been divided in 11 sections. There are mint as well as used stamps – blocks – on postcard – on cover and where possible the postal rates are calculated.

Inventor of perfin machine Mr. Joseph Sloper



Mr. Joseph Sloper (1813-1890) builder, decorator and inventor of the perforation process. His perforating machine could be used for perforating initials etc. on postage stamps, bankers' cheque's and other valuable documents, thus preventing fraud.


He was granted a patent for his device in 1858 and many firms began using his perforating machine.

In 1882 Sloper's perforating machine replaced the method of under printing on the back of stamps as the Post Offices approved method for protection against the theft of stamps and cheque's.


